Waiver:

The Pembina Valley Conservation District (PVCD) will provide the water tank, chlorine and other necessary tools to perform the shock chlorination. The PVCD is not responsible for any future water quality problems or complications with the well, pump or pipes. If you have a softener or other conditioning equipment, disconnect or bypass during procedure. Please read attached information on bio-fouling. By doing this procedure there is a risk that your well water supply equipment can become damaged.

Please follow the “NEXT DAY” instructions for the shock chlorination process.

(Landowners Responsibility)

1. After 8 -10 hours of the chlorinated water being put into the plumbing system (plan to do this overnight), pump water on to ground surface until smell of chlorine is gone. Avoid putting chlorinated water through your septic system, this could impair septic system if all this chlorinated water passes through it.
2. Do Not use this water for garden watering or flowers.
3. Run each faucet until the chlorine smell is gone.
4. Backwash all filters and softeners and flush your hot water tank.
5. You are done.

Hot Water Heater: For instructions on how to shock your hot water heater please see “Special Considerations” on attached fact sheet.

Note: If the shock chlorinating was completed because of high Coliforms or E-Coil bacteria, you should wait 2 weeks and then have your water re-tested.
